Well it's the end of January so it must be 24 hour build time again for the crazy modelers. This year's build was once again the last weekend in January with the build starting at twelve noon on Saturday and going till twelve noon on Sunday. This year's project was the Foose Cadillac Eldorado by Revell. This was one of the actual cars that was done by Foose in one to one scale and part of the line that Revell did in reproducing some of his replicas. The build itself was like in the past. Start out with body prep and paint so it can be drying and then moving on to the individual parts to be painted and prepped. Using paints by Tamiya and Testors Lacquers I was able to speed up the drying time of the smaller parts and sub-assemblies. All was going great until I went to clear coat the body early on Sunday morning. The clear went on great, but for some reason Murphy paid a visit. The clear just did not want to cooperate and decided to take on a mind of its own. So, I knew it could be fixed, but with the clock ticking down I knew it wouldn't be dry enough to sand and polish out by deadline. So as the clock struck twelve noon on Sunday I had a 95% done project. I let the body sit for about a week and then did the rub out and final assembly (bumpers, glass, etc.) to finally complete the build. So yes, it was fun again, yes it was a long 24 hours again and yes most definitely I will do it again next year!

# Categories: Check em' out!

- 1. SHOW ROOM STOCK: Any vehicle produced by a major manufacturer as presented on the show room fi
- 2. BOX STOCK: Built using parts supplied in the kit. Other decals and Baremetal foll is allowed.
- 3. STREET ROD: 1948 and older modified street legal vehicle.
- 4. STREET MACHINE: 1949 and newer modified street legal vehicles.
- 6. PRO STREET: Narrowed rear axle coupled with oversized rear wheels. Must be street legal.
- 8. CUSTOM: Major or minor body styling modifications. 7. LOWRIDERS: Modified so that its ground clearance is less than its design specification.
- 8. IMPORTS: Any automobile not manufactured in the United States.
- 9. TUNERS; American or Foreign vehicle built to replicate the latect "Tuner" style. 10. CURB SIDE: Models are judged as displayed on table, judges do not pick up the mo
- SLAMMERS: No engines or interiors. No panels or doors open. Judges do not plok up the models.
   SMALL SCALE: Vehicles 1/32 scale and smaller.
- 13. LARGE SCALE: Vehicles larger than 1/24 scale. 14. MOTORCYCLES: All Scales and Styles
- 15. JUNIORS: Ages 12 and under.
- 18. JUNIOR3: Ages 13 17.
- 17. UNFINISHED: Only one major comp
- 18. TRUCKS & VANS: Plok-ups, vans, 4x4's. Must be street legal.
- 18. COMMERCIAL & PUBLIC SERVICE: Light & heavy trucks, vans, fire, military, resour, police and taxi.
- 20. COMPETITION STRAIGHT LINE: All race cars that run in a straight line, Drag racing, Bonneville.
- 21. COMPETITION OUT OF BOX: All years and divisions. Aftermarket decais and Baremetal foll is allowed
- 22. COMPETITION NASCAR: 1990 and newer.
- 23. COMPETITION NASCAR HISTORICAL: 1989 and earlier. All divisions.
- 24. ALL OTHER COMPETITION: Must be automotive related.
- 26. MISCELLANEOUS: Any automotive related model that does not fit into one of the other categories.
- 28. DIORAMAS: Any type of scene involving an automotive subject.
- 27. THEME: Good vs. Evil: Any oar used for Good: Police Cars, Resoue Vehicles, Batmobile, Starsky & Hutch Torino. Evil: "Christine" Plymouth Fury, The Car, "Builit" 1988 Dodge Charger, etc.
