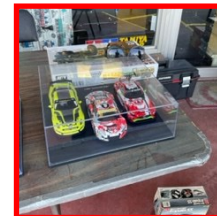
Keeping History Alive....One Model At A Time

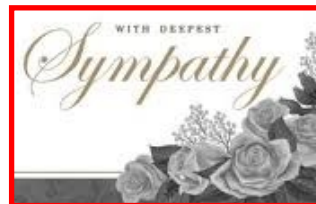

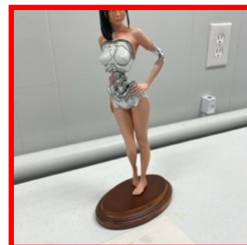
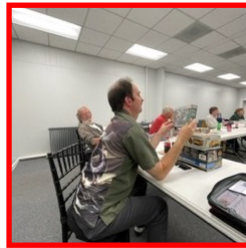
